CMF-1, CMF-2, CMF 65%, MDF, AEF

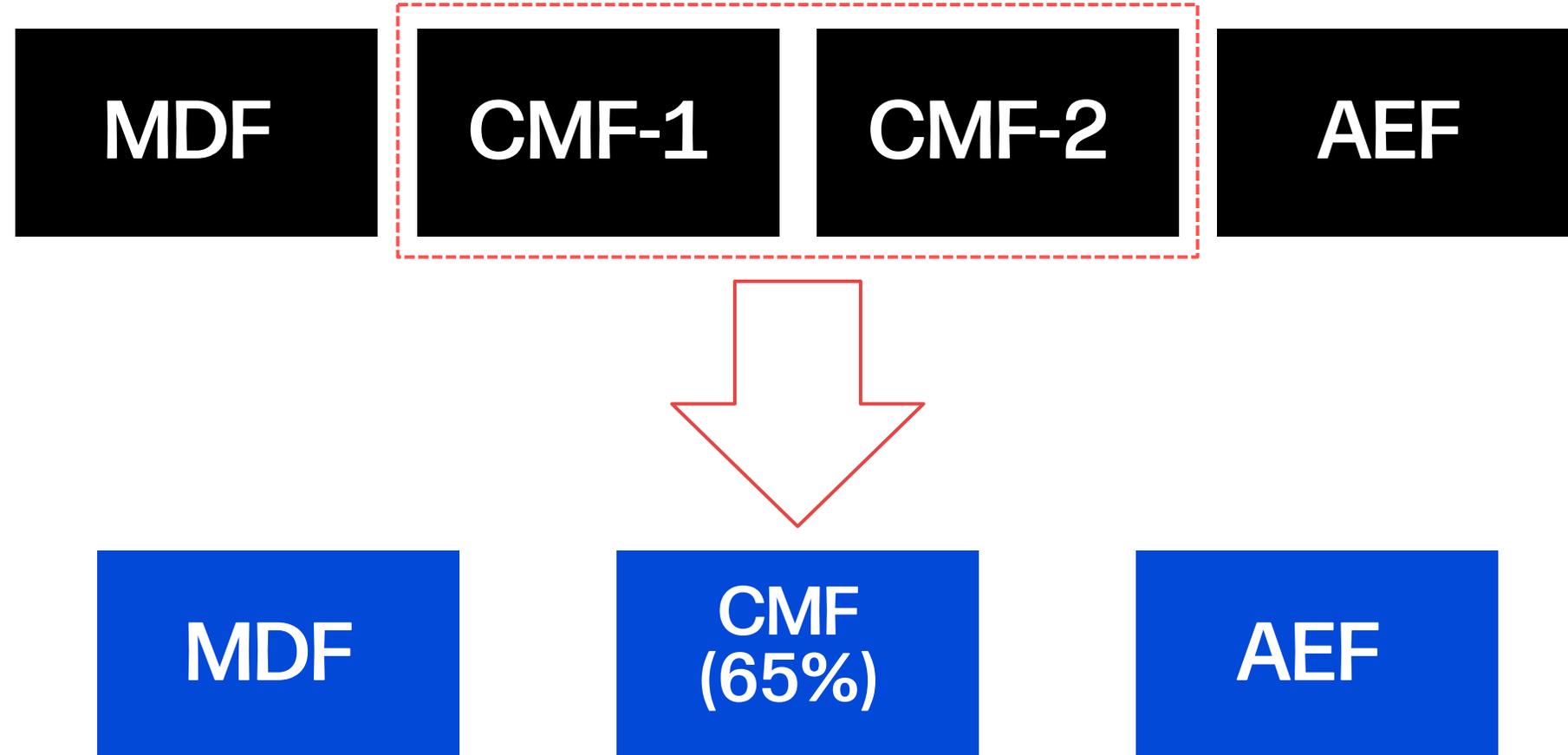


# CMF Program Consolidation

CMF1 and CMF2 are replaced by **one single CMF at 65% reimbursement**

Transition through April 30, then **CMF 65% becomes the only CMF option available**

All new submissions must use **CMF - 65%**

# AMD Activity Planning Process



Fund Allocation

to AMD

Execution

**GAM/MBA** allocate AMD funds to the different theaters, markets and orgs. Once finalized, the allocation is communicated to corresponding teams.

**The Campaign Owner** creates the Plan through the My Alliance Portal with the approved plan details.

**Make sure you submit your plans at least 10 DAYS prior to the start date. So we don't have issues with AMD approval.**

**Creatives must be approved by AMD.**

**The Alliance Partner Programs Ops Team** reviews:

- Dates of execution
- Budget requested
- Additional info

Alliance Partner Programs Ops team requests further information to Campaign Owner if needed.

**The Alliance Partner Programs Ops Team** submits activity information MPP (Marketing Performance Portal) and assigns activity ID

Campaign owner receives activity approval notification once AMD approves.

**The Campaign owner** may begin execution.

**Any changes after the start date must be communicated by the Campaign Owner to the Alliance Ops team and will be reviewed by AMD.**

# AMD POE and Claiming Process



## POE Upload

After execution, upload complete POE in My Alliance Portal within **30 days** of the activity end date.



## POE Review

Alliance Ops reviews POE and requests more info from the Campaign Owner if needed.

If POE is incomplete or incorrect, the system will send automatic follow-up notifications.



## Claim (Reimbursement Request)

Alliance Partner Programs Ops submits the reimbursement claim with supporting documents.

CO receives an automatic claim notification.

If an audit is triggered, Ops manages it – the Campaign Owner will be notified by email and **must respond ASAP to avoid risk of fund loss.**



## Payment Application

Alliance Partner Programs Ops monitors and reconciles partner payments.

Funds are transferred to the cost locations.

# Non-Negotiables: POE Rules

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POE is non-negotiable  
(**deadline - 30 days after activity end**).

If you can't prove it, it didn't happen. Upload POE on time, respond to AMD follow-ups, and ensure POE clearly follows the rules for that activity type.

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**POE must clearly show AMD benefit.**

URLs & Dates should be visible for all digital screenshots.  
AMD branding should be visible on photos (cannot be displayed on the screens).

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CMF now requires KPI/resulting metrics.

All CMF submissions must include **actual performance metrics** as part of POE.  
POE without documented metrics will not be considered complete.

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Don't over-POE.

Don't include POE unrelated to what was submitted to and approved by the partner.

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**Taxes are not reimbursed.**

Don't put just a single amount with tax included.  
Always have a tax added as a separate item in the invoice.

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**Proper naming - faster claiming.**

AMD wants to see a solid definition on the invoices and itemization.  
Put in a description that clearly explains the activity performed.

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Don't ignore AMD Audit requests!

No response within the deadline = **automatic claim cancellation and funding loss risk.**

# AMD 2026 Activity Types

- Activity types stay the same – enforcement is tighter.
- **Demo Units:** claim must include the AMD processor/model.
- **Paid Social:** POE must show start + end dates.
- **Retailer logic:** on retailer domain = onsite Search; different URL = Offsite
- **Performance report requirement:** must come from a system-generated or third-party source.
- **Report must include:** activity + dates + metrics + costs that match the executed activity.
